

Alcohol Ink Tips

Basic Supply List



Plus

I use cotton balls, plastic drip pan, small glass larger than paper with edges taped, gloves, freezer paper wax side done to protect table, non-porous surface to paint on like ceramic tiles or YUPO paper. Oh yes and canned air.

Alcohol Inks

At least 3 basic primary colors which are red, yellow and blue.

In the Pinata brand my favorite primaries that allow you to mix all colors.

Senorita Magenta

Baja Blue

Sunshine Yellow

Surface to Paint On

4.25x4.25 ceramic tiles

and or

Yupo paper cut in 5x7 (4 to 5 pieces it depends on how fast you paint)

or

any non-porous surface. Start small to begin with as the inks dry very fast.

91% alcohol (not 70%)

Welled palette

Small brush

Cotton balls

Cotton swabs

Paper towels

Gloves

Optional but highly recommended:

Thin permanent black pen

Aqua Brush

Ranger Blending Solution

Canned air

Stamper with felt also called Ink Applicator by Ranger Inks

Butcher paper with waxy side down to protect your table
