I use cotton balls, plastic drip pan, small glass larger than paper with edges taped, gloves, freezer paper wax side done to protect table, non-porous surface to paint on like ceramic tiles or YUPO paper. Oh yes and canned air.

Supply list for alcohol inks class

Alcohol ink, at least 6 colors (any brand, but class will be taught with Ranger inks and Pinata)

Yupo paper cut in 5x7 (4 to 5 pieces it depends on how fast you paint)

4.25x4.25 ceramic tiles

91% alcohol

Welled palette

Eyedropper or similar

Small brush

Cotton balls

Cotton swabs

Paper towels

Gloves

Optional but highly recommended:

Thin permanent black pen

Aqua Brush

Ranger Blending Solution

Stamper with felt

Canned air
