

Alcohol Ink Supplies for Flowers 04-10-21

Alcohol inks 3 minimum

Piñata Inks by Jacquard

3 primary colors (red, yellow, blue)

Ideal colors would be:

Senorita Magenta

Sunshine Yellow

Baja Blue

They have an Exciter Kit which is great with a lot more colors

Or if using Adirondack Ink by Ranger Inks

Again, a minimum of 3 primary colors

Raspberry

Sunshine Yellow

Sailboat Blue

They have a lot of really nice colors so you can add your favorites to this list.

Tiles 4.25 x 4.25 (I like to do tiles, so I buy a box of them at the hardware store.) Smooth white glazed tiles

Yupo paper You won't need a whole pad for this class one or two sheets should be fine. Or if the store is out of Yupo try Pixiss paper it is new, and I just ordered some. Or the back side of Kirkland Photo Paper

Plastic, latex, or latex-free, gloves

Q-tips

Cotton balls or makeup remover pads.

Paper towels

91% rubbing isopropyl alcohol. You can get at Walmart, Pharmacies, Food Stores

small squeeze bottles with nibs to squirt alcohol

small dish or cup to put alcohol ink (my favorite is a steel condiment cup)

"drip pan" I use an old plastic top to spinach

small round plastic palette

Plastic to protect your work surface or butcher paper with waxy side.

8x10 glass (the edge should be wrapped with tape for safety) or stiff surface to paint with Yupo. This is optional you will see it in the videos.

Canned Air I get a six-pack at Costco or your local office supply.

Optional Fun Supplies

micro dental brushes (these are like tiny q-tips and wonderful for small details)

Ranger Ink Blending Solution

Fillable Blender marker by Ranger Ink I fill this marker with Blending Solution to make an eraser or blender.

Ranger's Alcohol Ink Applicator and Pads This is great for doing leaves or foliage.

White Uni-Ball Signo Broad Point Gel Impact Pen or White gouache paint or white acrylic paint

White Posca Pens I really love these pens they are opaque and can cover any mistake or add accents.

Ranger Ink Blending Solution (really nice)

Alcohol Ink Pens or Markers There are many brands like Copic, Spectrum Noir, etc. This link is a good value.

Pentel Arts Aquash Water Brush, Small Brush, Fine Point Tip, 1 Pack

Fantastix these are like q-tips that you can use over and over.
