

Basic Alcohol Ink Supply Kit

INKS

Alcohol inks 3 minimum colors

3 primary colors (red, yellow, blue)

Ideal colors would be:

Senorita Magenta

Sunshine Yellow

Baja Blue

Or Piñata Inks Exciter Kit by Jacquard which is great value with a lot more colors

Or if using Adirondack Ink by Ranger Inks

Again, a minimum of 3 primary colors

Raspberry

Sunshine Yellow

Sailboat Blue

They have a lot of nice colors so you can add your favorites to this list.

SUBSTRATES

Tiles 4.25 x 4.25 or 6x6 (I like to do tiles, so I buy a box of them at the hardware store.)
Smooth white glazed tiles

MICELLANIOUS

Plastic, latex, or latex-free, gloves

Q-tips

Cotton balls or makeup remover pads.

Paper towels

91% rubbing isopropyl alcohol. You can get at Walmart, Pharmacies, Food Stores

small squeeze bottles with nibs to squirt alcohol

small dish or cup to put alcohol ink (my favorite is a steel condiment cup)

small round plastic palette

Plastic to protect your work surface or butcher paper with waxy side up.

Canned Air I get a six-pack at Costco or your local office supply.

OPTIONAL

Yupo paper 5x7 Yupo Paper Or if the store is out of Yupo I also really like Graphix Dura Bright 9x12 (I cut it up to 4x6) this goes all the way back to white with no staining

Small watercolor brush or brushes. Here is a good value pack.

"drip pan" I use an old plastic top to spinach

NOTES

Tiles are great to practice on but if you want to display them, they will need to be sealed as they will scratch very easily. [Here is a link with that info](#) for sealing tiles..

Substrates: most non-porous surfaces
